

# Fall 2022 Start Strong Overview

- Purpose
  - Meet federal flexibility for ELA, math, and science assessments for the 2021-2022 school year, including public reporting of school-level results disaggregated by subgroup.
  - Help school staff identify areas in need of support
- Standards aligned
  - Small set of prior year standards
- Subject areas
  - English Language Arts - Grades 4, 5, 6
  - Mathematics - Grades 4, 5, 6
  - Science - Grade 6

# Start Strong Scoring: Support Levels

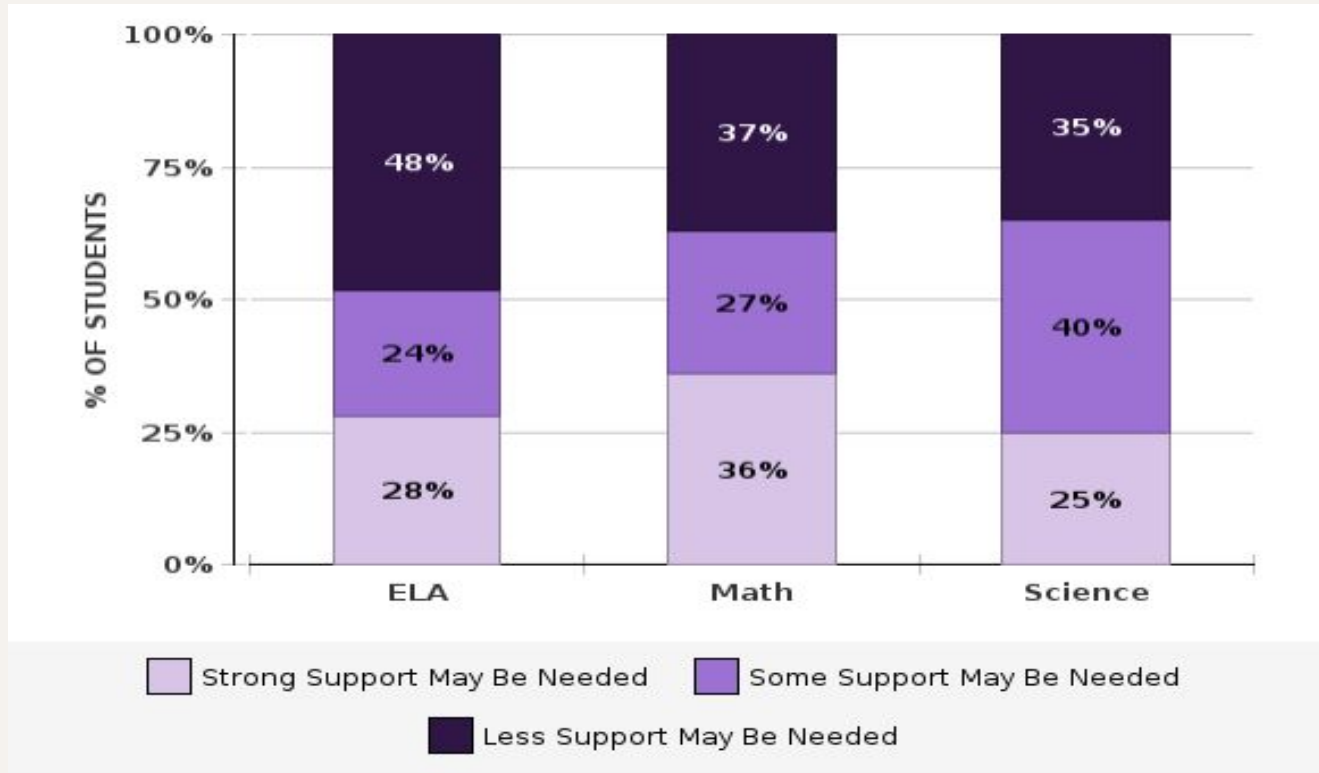
Level	Degree of Support

3	<b>Less Support May Be Needed</b>

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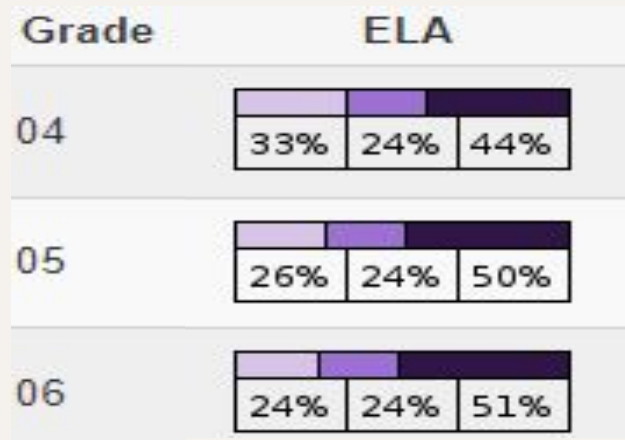
# Individual Score Reports

- Provided by NJDOE and sent to parents by school district
- Reports are currently available to staff for review
- Information provided to families:
  - A sense of the child's understanding in the tested content areas
  - A description of the major concepts tested
  - A starting point for discussion

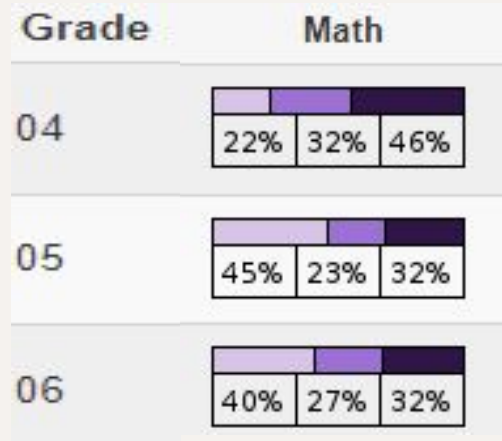
# Overall Scores




# English Language Arts Scores

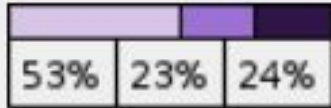

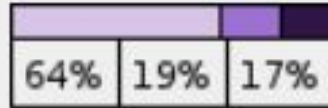

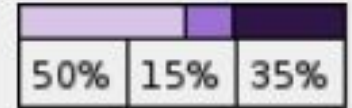

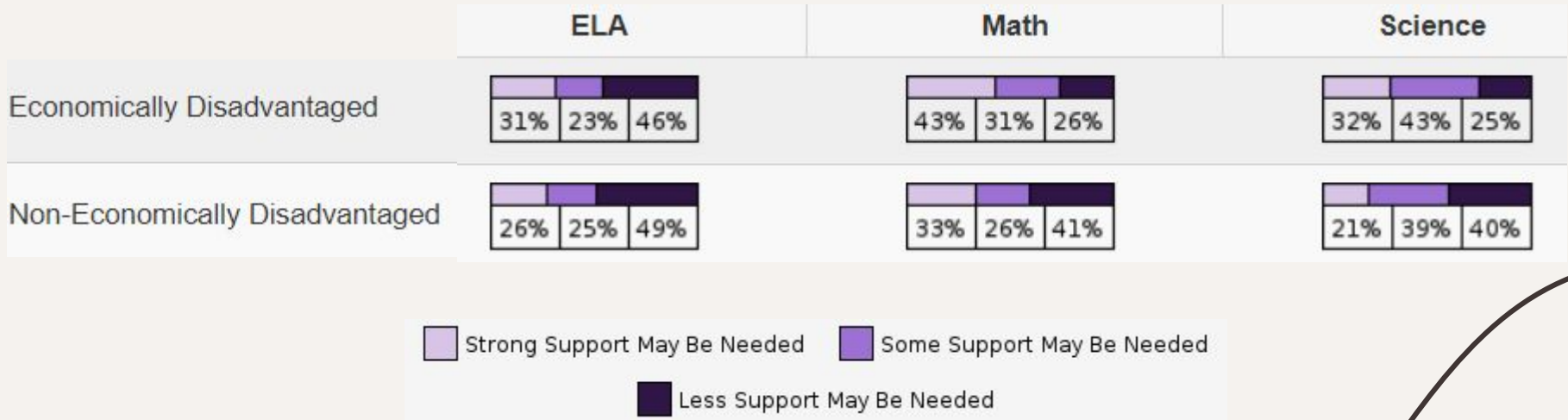
